**Discussion:**

- We shouldn't be looking at funding the two engineering students. The case competitions in Portland, Lincoln and Indiana are not linked, but they provide points in order to go to a larger case competition. They will likely come back to ask for more funding.
- Should we sponsor both teams for one, or both teams as one?
- Not only commerce students on the team,
- It's wrong to pay for this team to go to multiple places, but to go for a learning experience would be a good idea.
- Both teams should be funded, because there is no way for us to provide criteria as to who should go and who shouldn't. Should we fund both teams to go to both?
- Should we sponsor teams to go to both competitions
- We want to reimburse only commerce students. We don't pay for hotel or food.

- Both teams are going to Lincoln, so we could just fund the Lincoln Case Competition
- With our policy, we should cover the trip and then give a subsidy to cover the other case competition.
